The Impact of this Policy is:

- Systematic testing (drills) of the emergency response system shall be conducted regularly to verify effectiveness, and any identified improvements implemented promptly.
- Mutual emergency aid arrangements shall be maintained with Government and external organizations.
- Contractors shall be required to and manage emergency response in line with this policy.

The Purpose of this Policy is to:

- AETS shall conform to a standardized emergency response procedure to mitigate injury to People, damage asset, and protect the Environment to sustain Reputation of the organization.
- Provide assurance to stakeholders to ensure the commitment to manage emergencies in all operations.
